



BACKGROUND OF CHRISTIAN COMMITTEE OF CONCERN

The Christian Committee of Concern (CCC) was organized in May 1968, by Robert King, Jr., Jerome McFarland and Vernon C. Watford. They saw a need of presenting the Gospel to the people in Resurrection City who were as sheep without a shepherd. Upon discovering that there were physical as well as spiritual needs existing, Robert, Jerome and Vernon worked unceasingly in presenting the Word of God to all people, and also tried to meet whatever physical needs they could.

CCC has workers who make door-to-door visitations presenting the Gospel of Jesus Christ to people by tract distribution and personal witnessing. The Christian Committee of Concern has qualified Bible teachers who are eager to conduct classes in homes, churches, clubs, etc. The District of Columbia Bible Institute of Washington, DC, Triple C Bible Institute and Camp, Inc., Excel Ministries of Washington, DC are ministries begun by the CCC Missionaries. Other ministries of this type are envisioned throughout America.

“Pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that He will send forth laborers into His Harvest.” Matthew 9:38

THE CHRISTIAN COMMITTEE IS PRIMARILY CONCERNED WITH:

- Presenting the Gospel of Jesus Christ to all people.
- Teaching those who need and desire instruction, as far as present-day living is concerned moral and religious instruction.
- Meeting whatever genuine physical needs are discovered (if funds are available).
- Establishing local Bible believing churches among Black Americans.

“Go ye therefore and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and the Son, and of the Holy Spirit; Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the world. AMEN. Mathew 28: 19-20.

In 1976, Robert, Jerome and Vernon felt they had a great need to get away from their immediate surroundings and go to a place where they could pray together for other ministries as well as their own. They stopped at the Econo Lodge in Petersburg, VA and prayed. In 1977 they decided to get away again and pray; this time they took their wives with them. In 1978 they decided to get away again; and this time they opened it up to others. As a result, the **PRAYER FOR MINISTRIES RETREAT** was born and we are here today to PRAISE THE LORD, FELLOWSHIP AND PRAY.
